

# Weston PTO's Community Day



Please join us on Wednesday, April 7th (early release day) to celebrate the Weston PTO's First Annual Community Day!

As we head into Spring, Weston Elementary students are invited to help make our town a little brighter. Students may choose to participate in any ONE of the following activities.

A) Create "emotionally intelligent" Signs - Help design traffic signs that drivers will truly notice - whether asking motorists to slow down or be aware of crosswalks, what would catch your attention? The Department of Public Works/Weston Police will review the final products and possibly use these signs on our streets!

B) BINGO/Board Games - Join our friends at the Council on Aging for some lively BINGO and other Board Games.

C) Food Art - Ever wonder how to make art from the food we eat? Join us as we learn from a local expert how to create an edible masterpiece! Must be in Grade 3 or up to participate.

D) Spring Cleaning - Let's freshen up our school grounds and bring cheer to all who use them. We'll mulch, plant pansies, and have a scavenger hunt for trash! Please dress appropriately for this outdoor activity. (Unless extremely inclement weather, we will plan to be outside).

E) Land's Sake - Join us as we remove rocks from the fields at Land's Sake Farm to protect tractors and improve crop growth at our neighboring farm. Must be in Grade 3 or up to participate. Please dress appropriately for this outdoor activity. (Unless extremely inclement weather, we will plan to be outside).

Registration is handled on a first-come, first-served basis and sign-up is required. Please note that transportation is not provided - Registered participants are to be dropped off at the Council on Aging at 12:45PM and picked up at 2:45PM at the Field School Cafeteria (see schedule below). Participant numbers are limited so please register as soon as possible. (Total Participation Limited to 60 students). Please note all activities will be supervised by at least 2 adults, in addition to the activity instructor.

2PM - 2:45PM - Community Day Celebration in Field School Cafeteria
